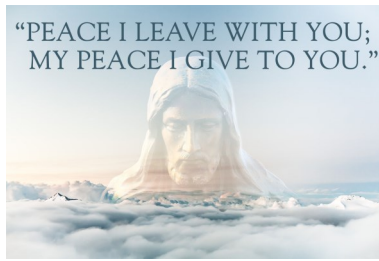

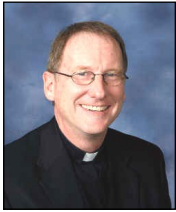

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

Jake Schneider, a lifelong St. Charles parishioner, is being ordained a deacon on Saturday morning this weekend, and he will be preaching his first homily at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses on Sunday. We are grateful to God for his vocation. Deacon Jake will be assigned to a parish for the summer and then return to the seminary for one more year. His priesthood ordination is scheduled for June of 2023. We continue to pray for our seminarians and we pray that more young men and women will hear and answer the call to the Priesthood or Religious Life.

Every year the diocese sends a missionary to preach in our parishes. Next weekend, Fr. Ken Amadi will join us and speak at all of the Masses about his home diocese in Nigeria. Fr. Ken is currently serving in our diocese at St. Joseph Parish in Mishawaka.

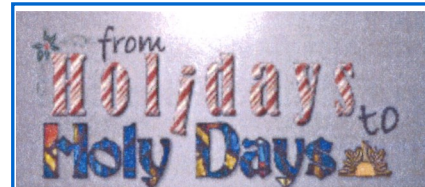
We are counting down the days until we have our own church once again. While our gym has worked well for these five months, I think that we all look forward to celebrating the Eucharist in a real church without folding chairs and bleachers, without a rolling altar and a tabernacle on wheels. I think we are looking forward also to air conditioning, a cry room, cushioned pews, and all of the history that we share in our sacred worship space. When the people of Israel were in slavery in Babylon, they longed to return to their holy city and to their Temple. I think that we can relate. We are close. Bishop Rhoades is coming for a Mass at **7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 31**, as we return to our church. Many of our former St. Charles Priests are returning to join us at that Mass and we would love to have a crowd. After the Mass, we will offer mini tours with explanations of the artwork and the renovation process, and we will have an ice cream social outside. For those who can't be here in person, check our website for a livestream link.

A word about hearing loops. The sound system in the church will be up and running by May 31st, and we are excited to have a hearing loop installed. Many hearing aids have a "T" button for "telecoil." With a push of that button, the hearing aid is tuned in directly to the church microphones. It is my understanding that not all models of hearing aids have the telecoil, but hearing aid manufacturers are able to add it to many existing models at a relatively low cost. We are also purchasing a few sets of receivers with earbuds which can be borrowed by those without hearing aids.

Renovation, Week 19. Work continues on the terrazzo floor as steps are installed, the sanctuary floors are ground and polished, and terrazzo base plates are mounted around the church. Carpet is going in the reconciliation rooms and the cry room, and the sound system is being installed and calibrated. Professional cleaners will be coming this week, needing two days to deal with all of the dust in our church, and the organ installation people are coming this week from Kansas, needing three to four days to reinstall the pipe organ.

I've include a photo taken last week as our new crucifix was suspended above the altar. The corpus of the crucifix was carved in Germany and the cross was made by parishioners, using oak lumber which was removed from our sanctuary. The seventh and eighth graders from our school came to watch, and as word spread, we had about a hundred other spectators to see the crucifix raised above the altar and suspended. It was a wonderful moment.

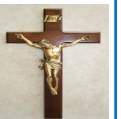
