

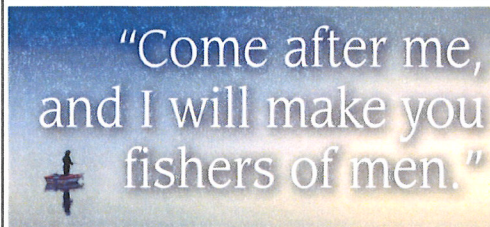

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Our parish directories have arrived! If you had a photo taken for the directory, we have a free directory for you. Volunteers from the Parish Council will be distributing the directories in the Gathering Space after Masses this weekend. We will have extra copies for purchase, but we are going to wait a week or two before offering that in order to have the bulk of the distribution done.

The Annual North East Indiana March for Life will be begin this Saturday, Jan. 27, at the St. Francis Center for Performing Arts (formerly the Scottish Rite Theatre). Doors open at 11:30 a.m. and a program begins at noon. State Senator Liz Brown will be the featured speaker this year. After the program, a quiet walk through city streets serves as a witness to our concern for children in the womb and our belief that unborn babies need our protection.

The Borromeo Bash is a formal dinner with auction and casino games, a benefit for our parish school. It is also a good way to have fun with other St. Charles adults. SCRIP NEWS



SCRIP Credit Statements are now available for pickup. This report shows the money you earned from purchasing SCRIP. Please stop by the table in the Gathering Space after all masses this weekend, January 20-21, for pickup. Even if you haven't purchased SCRIP in a while, please stop by the table and check if you have any unclaimed funds. We have researched our records and found some outstanding credits from the past.

You will need to sign the report and turn it back in immediately. Due to the closing, you can no longer save credit statements for the future. Remember, your portion of the money can be used for many different things, such as school tuition and lunch accounts, donating it to the St. Vincent DePaul Society, Capital Improvement Fund, or other parish ministries. If you do not want to use your credits for these options, you may request a refund in the form of a family rebate check.

If you don't have a chance this weekend, you can pick up your credit statement at the Parish Office between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on weekdays. However, if we do not receive the signed report by March 31, 2024, we will be required to turn the money over to the State of Indiana as unclaimed funds.

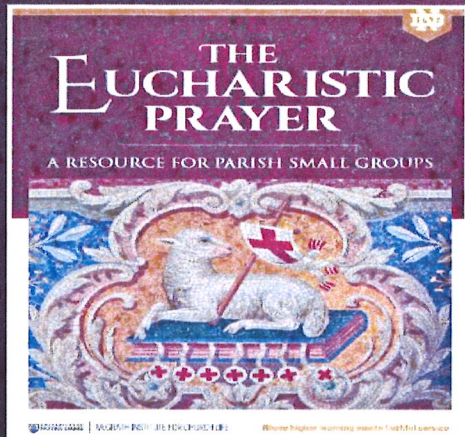
