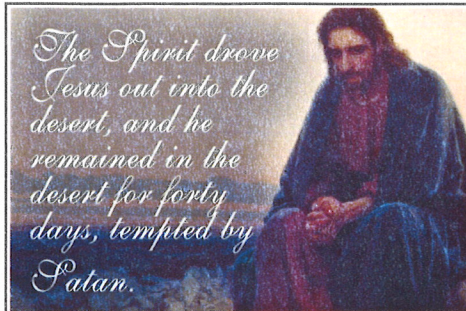

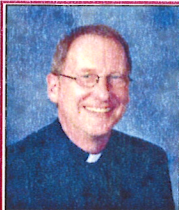

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Lent has begun. This is our sacred time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Most important, this is our time to focus on our God. God can be squeezed out of busy lives; we need to focus. We offer extra opportunities for prayer during Lent: Stations of the Cross with Benediction will be offered every Friday evening at 7:00 p.m., and Stations will be offered at 3:00 p.m. on Sundays in Lent. We also expose the Blessed Sacrament in the daily Mass chapel from 7:30 a.m. -8:00 a.m. on weekdays.

Our parish 40 Hours Devotion begins next weekend. Father Patrick Mary Briscoe, a young Dominican priest and a graduate of our parish school, will be here to preach at the weekend Masses and then to preach at Evening Prayer at 7:00 p.m. on both Sunday and Monday and a Mass at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday (February 25, 26, and 27.) We need to have committed people who will be in the church to pray from 7:00 p.m. on Sunday through 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday. If you haven't signed up, please do so. We have sign-up sheets in the Gathering Space or you can sign up by going to our parish website and clicking on the orange banner at the top of the home page. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed day and night on those days, with the exception of morning Mass times. This is a beautiful chance to spend quiet time in the presence of the Lord.

The Rite of Sending will take place at the 9:00 a.m. Mass this weekend. Those adults who have been in the RCIA, preparing to become Catholic, will be recognized and we will pray over them at our Mass. In the afternoon, they will go to the Cathedral, where Bishop Rhoades will recognize them and offer prayer for them.

We still have many families who have not picked up their picture directory. If you had a photo taken and don't yet have a directory, stop by the parish during business hours or catch an usher or priest before or after Mass. For those who didn't have a photo taken for the directory, we have extra copies available, requesting a \$10 donation.

Finally, we have made another commitment with our recent bequest. Father Wimal, a Sri Lankan priest, has been serving in our Diocesan Tribunal and has been pastor of St. Mary's Parish for a number of years. He was also known to help at St. Charles with school confessions when requested. Fr. Wimal has now been called back to Sri Lanka, where he will be ordained bishop of his diocese on March 2. He is returning to an area of poverty and difficult political tensions. Having no car and no funds to purchase a car, some friends asked if we could help. We have sent an international wire transfer to allow the new bishop to purchase a car.

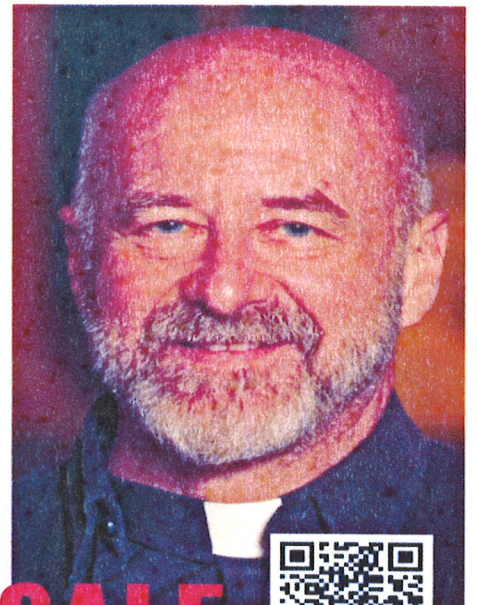
AVA'S GRACE RETREAT FOR COUPLES GRIEVING THE LOSS OF A BABY BEFORE OR AFTER BIRTH

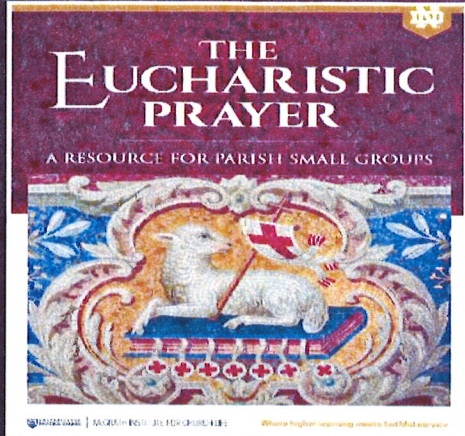

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE—All Catholics who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING—All Catholics from their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday are bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting requires limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light nourishment may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Any good reason will excuse a person from these regulations on particular occasions and for health and dietary needs. Only a contemptuous violation of all regulations would be considered seriously wrong.
