A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

I offer thanks to Josh Schipper for his words last weekend about the Perpetual Adoration Chapel at St. Jude. I find it inspiring to see so many people going to the chapel for adoration, and especially inspiring to see so many teens and young adults. The chapel has a fine website where you can sign up for a weekly hour, or you can sign up to be a substitute when needed. For those who have a regular hour but occasionally cannot be there, it is easy to send an alert to the subs. The website is: stjudeadorationchapel.webs.com.

Thank you to all who supported our Redeemer Radio Sharathon hour. Our Catholic radio station reaches a lot of people and is building up the faith through the diocese. We are grateful for all who make it possible.

I also need to offer more thanks to our Knights of Columbus for their countless good works around the parish. Last week they hosted a Thursday night spaghetti supper to help with medical expenses of a five-year-old parishioner battling cancer. They also removed pew cushions in the church in preparation for an organ concert. On Friday they served a reception for the concert and replaced the pew cushions late in the evening. On Saturday, they hosted a blood drive and they began a project of cleaning out the youth house garage in order to provide storage space for Walking with Moms in Need. This is one active group!

Finally, I offer a personal note. When I was first assigned to St. Charles, my parents came from Lafayette to see the parish...and to offer their approval. They attended a school Mass and reported afterwards how impressed they were by the reverence of our school children, the friendliness of our parish, and the beauty of our church. My Mom then asked: "But why don't you have a tabernacle in your church?" I repeated my Mom's question many times over the past few years. As we planned a church renovation, then carried out a capital campaign, and then celebrated Mass for five months in the gym during the renovation, I told the story of Mom's question often. And now, an update: I am happy to report that my Mom, (age 92), returned to St. Charles this year on Easter. And I am happy to report that she loves the renovation. I guess I can stay.

**EUCHARTISTIC REVIVAL
APRIL, 2023**

Receiving the Eucharist presupposes that one is in communion with the Church. If a Catholic were knowingly and obstinately to reject the defined doctrines or moral teachings of the Church, he or she would seriously diminish his or her communion with the Church and should thereby refrain from receiving Holy Communion. Before we receive Holy Communion, we should make a good examination of conscience to ensure that we are properly disposed. If we find that we have broken communion with Christ and his Church, the sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation provides us with the merciful opportunity to recover the gift of sanctifying grace and to be restored to full communion with God and the Church.

MONTHLY SAINT OF THE EUCHARIST

St. Catherine of Sienna was a third-order Dominican known for her great care of the sick and her profound love of Jesus in the Eucharist. Visions and ecstasies often lasting 3-4 hours took place at Communion. For the seven-year period prior to her death, St. Catherine took no food into her body other than the Eucharist. She once wrote, "O man, what has your God left you? He has left you Himself, wholly God and wholly Man, concealed under the whiteness of bread. O fire of love! In the excess of Your love for Your creature, You gave to man your whole divine essence." She was declared a doctor of the church in 1970 and a patron saint of Europe in 1999. Her feast day is April 29.

IMPORTANT NOTICE for all Kohl's shoppers! Kohl's has made a policy change for their Kohl's credit card. **Starting June 26, 2023, you will NOT be allowed to pay your Kohl's charge card bill using gift cards.** SCRIP has a limited supply of gift cards on hand that can be used toward your credit card bill until the June 26 deadline. After that date, only in-store and online purchases can be made with gift cards. Online customers who purchase Kohl's e-gift cards from RaiseRight after April 11, 2023, can only use those e-cards for purchases, and cannot be used to pay your credit card bill (even if before June 26.) 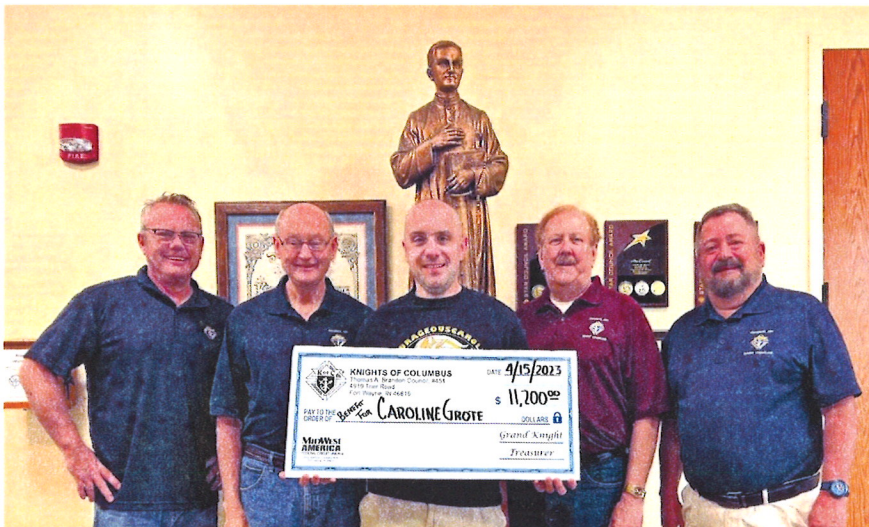
