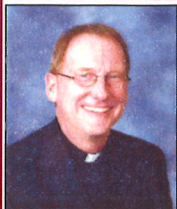

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Today is Pentecost, one of the three greatest feasts in the Church year. We remember the Holy Spirit coming into the world to make us a holy Church and to make each of us holy people. Our God is in our midst. May we always follow His promptings.

I plan to be in Lafayette with my family this weekend. My little great-nephew from Pennsylvania will get a chance to meet his Hoosier relatives.

A Eucharistic Procession is a long-standing tradition in the Catholic Church. The Blessed Sacrament is carried through the streets with great honor, witnessing our Catholic faith through the neighborhood. We will have our Annual Parish Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession on June 11 at the end of the 11:00 a.m. Mass, walking around the parish property on Reed and Trier. This year, the Bishop has also given special permission for our high school ministry leaders to organize a Eucharistic Procession to begin our high school summer series. All high schoolers and 8th grade graduates are welcome to join us on Wednesday evening at 7:00 p.m. at the Youth Ministry House. There will be activities and snacks after the procession.

Next weekend, is an important weekend in the life of the Church and in the life of our parish. Seven young men will be ordained priests on Saturday morning. Among them is Deacon Jake Schneider, a lifelong St. Charles parishioner. Because there are so many being ordained, admission to the Cathedral will be by invitation only, but the liturgy will be available on livestream. Go to the diocesan website, diocesefwsb.org to take part in this very impressive liturgy. And please keep Deacon Jake in your prayer.

We are very honored that *Father Jake* will have his First Mass here at St. Charles next Sunday, June 4. He will preside at our 11:00 a.m. Mass, and everyone is invited to that Mass. Monsignor Michael Heintz will preach the homily, we will have trumpets and drums and a beautiful liturgy. After the Mass, we will have a luncheon in the Hession Center, with a chance to receive the blessing of our newest priest.

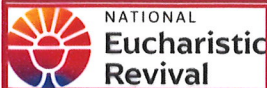

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL
SAINT OF THE
MONTH OF MAY

St. Dominic Savio (1842-1857) was the second of eleven children born to a poor, hard-working, pious family in Italy. He attended the school founded by St. Don Bosco. He died at the age of 14, having achieved remarkable sanctity, with a special devotion to the Eucharist: "Ask Jesus to make you a saint. After all, only He can do that." "Go to confession regularly and to Communion as often as you can." "I need nothing in this world in order to be happy. I only need to see Jesus in heaven, Whom I now see and adore on the altar with the eyes of faith." "Mary, I give you my heart. Always keep it yours." "Jesus, Mary, always be my friends. I beg you, let me die rather than be so unfortunate as to commit a single sin." St. Dominic Savio's Feast Day was May 6.

The lives of the saints and blessed show us the importance of the Eucharist on our journey as disciples of Jesus. Many testify to the power of the Eucharist in their lives. We see the fruits of Holy Communion in their lives of faith, hope, and charity. It was their intimate union with Jesus in Holy Communion and frequently their prayer before the Blessed Sacrament that nourished and strengthened them in their journey to heaven. They teach us that "growth in Christian life needs the nourishment of Eucharistic Communion, the bread for our pilgrimage until the moment of death, when it will be given to us as viaticum."

In recent years, increasing numbers of Christians in our country have left their churches and become religiously unaffiliated. We invite Catholics who have left the Church or who no longer practice the faith to come home. We miss you and we love you. We pray that Jesus will draw you back to your Catholic family, his Mystical Body, through his Eucharistic Body. We repeat words attributed to St. Teresa of Calcutta: "Once you understand the Eucharist, you can never leave the Church. Not because the Church won't let you but because your heart won't let you."
