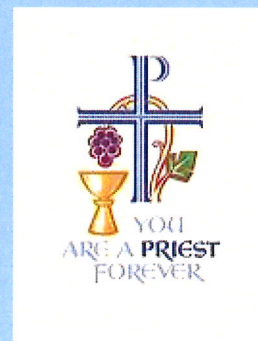

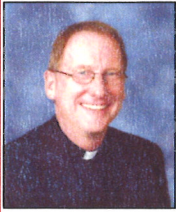

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This is an important weekend in our parish with the ordination of our newest priest, Father Jake Schneider. Fr. Jake is the son of Andy and Tina Schneider and a lifelong St. Charles member. His first Mass will be at our parish 11:00 a.m. Mass this weekend, with a reception to follow in the Hession Center. Even if you can't join us for the 11:00 a.m. Mass, you are very welcome to stop by for the reception. We will have pasta and cake and a chance to receive a blessing from our new priest.

We offer prayer for Fr. Koehl as he packs and makes all of the necessary plans for his move to North Manchester. There are a thousand details to take care of while organizing a move and taking on a new assignment. He will preach at all of the Masses on his final weekend here, June 17/18. We will have a simple reception after the 11:00 a.m. Mass on June 18 to thank him for his two years of dedicated service at St. Charles.

We will host a presentation from the Aging and In-Home Service Agency on Thursday, June 8, at 1:00 p.m. in the Community Room. This group will explain the ins and outs of caring for an elderly person at home in the face of memory loss or physical infirmity. All are welcome.

Next weekend is Corpus Christi Sunday. It has been several years since we have had a Corpus Christi Procession at St. Charles due to the diocesan procession in Warsaw last year and the pandemic before that. We are inviting our recent graduates of second and third grade to lead the procession in their First Communion clothes (if they still fit) and to toss flower petals along the way. We will leave the church after the 11:00 a.m. Mass, walk around our property, and return to the church for Benediction, finishing at 12:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome.

Finally, I will mention that we have a new parish picture directory in the planning stages. Our last directory was printed seven years ago and it is time for an update. Everyone who has a photo taken for the directory will receive a free 8 x 10 photo and also a copy of the directory when it is printed. Additionally, I would guess that many will want to buy photos as keepsakes or as gifts. The photographer will be stationed in the church nursery at the end of the summer, and we will have a simple process to make an appointment online. For those who would rather talk to a person than a computer, we will also have volunteers available after Masses to help make appointments as well. Watch for more information.

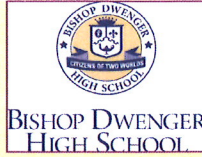
