A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

This has been an exciting week at St. Charles. Everyone in our school has been excited to begin summer vacation, and everyone in the parish has been excited to return to our church. Our church has been our place of worship since 1975 and it is good to be back. I am grateful for the patience and the flexibility of the parish, dealing with Masses in the gym and the Gathering Space. I am also grateful for the work of all who made this possible.

Our church renovation is basically done, though there are some details still to address. Some of our lighting will change, we will likely need adjustments to the sound system, and the terrazzo floor has a few areas which need attention. Next, we are investigating new doors in our Reconciliation Rooms and we are looking at options for better ventilation in the Cry Room.

As we have returned to our church, we are returning to most of our old liturgical practices. Ushers will pass the collection basket, volunteers will bring forward offertory gifts, and servers will carry out more functions. Unfortunately, following two and a half years with pandemic and renovation, we find that we have lost many ministers. We are in need of more Sacristans, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Ushers, and Servers. We are especially in need of people who can help at the 5:00 p.m. Sunday evening Mass. If you have been a liturgical minister in the past and would like to volunteer again, please contact us. If you have never had one of the positions but you would be willing to help, please contact us. We provide training and have a flexible scheduling system that allows changes and trades when needed. This weekend we are beginning our *Pause and Praise* time of worship between the 9:00 and 11:00 Masses on Sunday morning. Come to the Hession Center to spend a half hour in prayer of praise. Child care is offered for those with little ones.

Please remember in prayer our three new priests, ordained this weekend: Fr. LeeAllen Fortin, Fr. Mark Hellinger, and Fr. Brian Isenbarger. Next year, we are hopeful of having seven men ordained priests, including our own parishioner, Deacon Jake Schneider.

I include today a picture of the crucifix which now stands over the tabernacle in the chapel. I'm told that it belonged to Monsignor Suelzer and was bought from the woodcarvers in Oberammergau, Germany. It is a beautiful piece of carving, and I think it is a beautiful addition to our daily Mass chapel. We plan to return to our former use of that chapel, with the 6:15 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. daily Masses in the chapel. We also plan to return to the Reconciliation Rooms in the chapel for confessions. We haven't used the chapel since the pandemic began. It will be good to return to normal.

EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION AND FESTIVAL

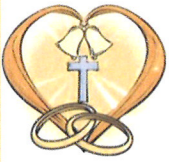
Join us for a family-friendly Eucharistic Procession and Festival on the afternoon of
