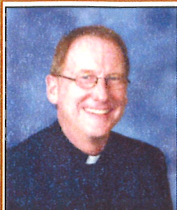

Part of the campaign for the parish picture directory involves the pastor recording a phone message which will be automatically sent out to parishioner phone numbers. This is a very deliberate attempt to reach out to parish members who aren't here at Sunday Mass and don't read the bulletin. I'm sure that none of us like robo-calls, but please bear with me for this one-time call.

A final note: a parishioner told me that she saw a dog locked in a car during Mass last weekend. Please don't leave a pet in the car during summertime.

SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS

Months of JUNE & JULY

Sign-up book is located in the Gathering Space.

Each Sunday a family, couple, or individual will come forward during the Parish Vocation Prayer to receive the "**Vocation Cross and A Special Book of Vocation Prayers**" written for each day of the week. In taking the cross, they commit themselves to pray during the week to encourage more vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. The Vocation Cross would need to be returned to the Sacristy before the following weekend's Masses.

EUCCHARISTIC SAINT FOR JUNE: ST. THOMAS MORE



St. Thomas More (1478-1535) was born in London. With a reputation for being honest and effective, he served King Henry VIII, rising to become Lord Chancellor in 1529.

Thomas was ultimately beheaded by the King for his fidelity to the Catholic faith. Of the Eucharist, he said, "Now, when we have received Our Lord, let us not then leave Him alone as we get involved in other things. Instead, let all our concern be focused on Him. Let us by devout prayer and meditation talk with Him. Let us say with the prophet: 'I will hear what our Lord will speak within me.' If we set aside all other things and attend to Him, He will inspire us and grant us great spiritual comfort and profit. Having received the Blessed Sacrament, we have a special time of prayer. Let us not allow this occasion to slip by. St. Thomas More's feast day is June 22. Learn more about his Eucharistic devotion at diocesefwsb.org/eucharist.

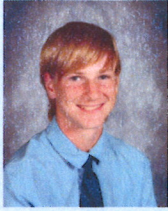

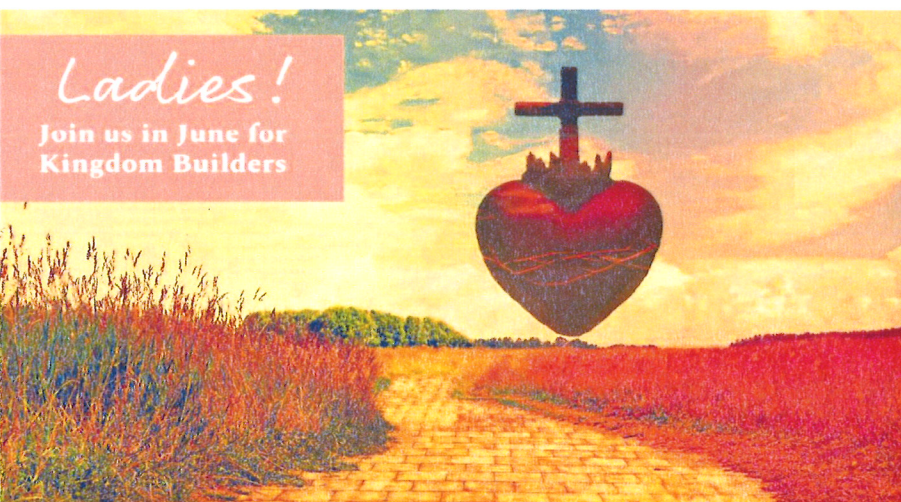

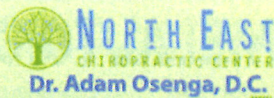
