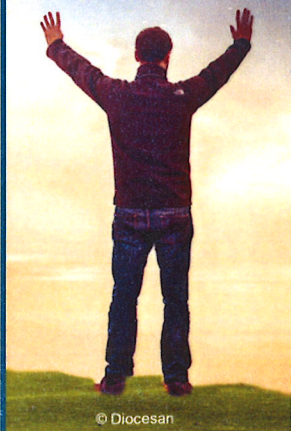

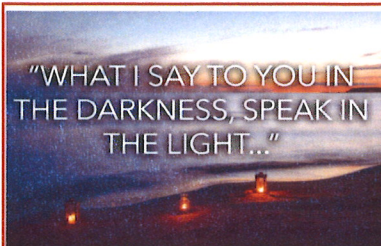

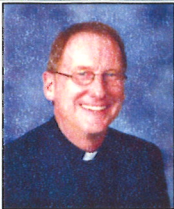

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Tuesday was the annual day of priestly transfers. On Tuesday, Fr. Dennis moved from North Manchester to Monroeville, Fr. Koehl moved from St. Charles to North Manchester and Fr. Bobby arrived to begin his first priestly assignment here at St. Charles. There is always an awkward transition as one priest moves all of his belongings out and another moves all of his belongings in on the same day. That doesn't leave much time for cleaning or organizing and it leaves priests scrambling to find everything they need. I remember my move to my previous parish; I thought that I had everything pretty well in order, but I got up in the morning for my first parish Mass and couldn't find my black shoes anywhere.

Fr. Bobby's baptismal name is Robert, but he has always used "Bobby" and plans to continue that as a priest. That is, in fact, a big help in our diocese; we have three priests named "Fr. Bob." Fr. Bobby's e-mail will be fatherbobby@scbfw.org and his phone will be extension 4 at our parish number, 482-2186. In addition to his assignment at St. Charles, Fr. Bobby will be a chaplain at Bishop Dwenger High School. He will be there regularly for confessions, Masses, and school events, occasionally teaching in Religion classes, too.

The diocese organizes a priest retreat each year at the hotel at Pokagon State Park. This is the week of the priest retreat. Both Fr. James and Fr. Bobby will be gone for that retreat from Monday afternoon until Friday afternoon. I am remaining in the parish, covering Masses and holding down the fort. I will be gone for a retreat at the end of July.

We have had a lot of people signing up for appointments for our new parish picture directory. If you haven't yet made an appointment to have your photo taken, I would encourage you not to delay. You can make an appointment easily with an electronic sign-up. For those who know how to use a QR code, it is found in this bulletin and also on the television monitors in the Gathering Space. For those who know how to link to a website, you can do that on our parish website or Facebook page. For those who like real people better than computers, we are organizing volunteers at a table in the Gathering Space after Masses to sign you up. At some point you may also receive an electronic telephone call from me, reminding you of the sign-ups. None of us likes these robo-calls, but it is an effort to reach out to families who aren't here at Mass and aren't eagerly reading the pastor's column in the bulletin. It will be a one-time call.

St. Thomas More (1478-1535) was born in London. With a reputation for being honest and effective, he served King Henry VIII, rising to become Lord Chancellor in 1529.

Thomas was ultimately beheaded by the King for his fidelity to the Catholic faith. Of the Eucharist, he said, "Now, when we have received Our Lord, let us not then leave Him alone as we get involved in other things. Instead, let all our concern be focused on Him. Let us by devout prayer and meditation talk with Him. Let us say with the prophet: 'I will hear what our Lord will speak within me.' If we set aside all other things and attend to Him, He will inspire us and grant us great spiritual comfort and profit. Having received the Blessed Sacrament, we have a special time of prayer. Let us not allow this occasion to slip by. St. Thomas More's feast day is June 22. Learn more about his Eucharistic devotion at diocesefwsb.org/eucharist.

The Truth About **Abortion** & **Women's Health**

Abortion does not save women's lives.

Abortion is the **direct** and **intentional** killing of a child in the womb.

Abortion is never medically necessary. It does not treat or solve any pregnancy-related complication.

Outlawing abortion will not affect treatment for miscarriage.

Treatment for miscarriage and abortion is not the same thing.

There is a complete moral and legal difference between losing a child through miscarriage and intentionally taking the life of a child.

In the tragic case of miscarriage, surgery may be necessary—and is an ethical treatment—to remove the remains of an unborn child who has *already died*.

While the same surgery is done to perform an abortion, abortions impose this procedure on a **living child** with the **intention** of ending his or her life.

Women can get the lifesaving treatments they need—without abortion.

In rare cases, and in the absence of better alternatives, life-threatening maternal health conditions may require interventions that **indirectly** and **unintentionally** lead to the death of an unborn child. **Abortion restrictions will not prevent women from receiving these treatments.**

When the lives of mother and child are in immediate danger, the goal is to fight to save both patients. **Effective treatments exist that seek to save the life of the mother and never to intentionally harm her unborn child.**

When a woman's life is at risk in pregnancy, preterm delivery may be used as a lifesaving medical intervention to preserve the life of both mother and child.¹

Ectopic pregnancies result when an embryo implants outside the uterus—often in the fallopian tube. Sadly, such embryos cannot survive and this condition can pose serious risks to the mother. While ectopic pregnancies sometimes resolve naturally, interventions are often necessary.

When done ethically, treatment for an ectopic pregnancy is not abortion. Ethical interventions include the removal of the damaged fallopian tube containing the embryo or, if embryo death has already occurred, medication can be used to resolve the ectopic pregnancy.

Bottom line: Abortion restrictions never prevent women from receiving life-saving treatment.²
