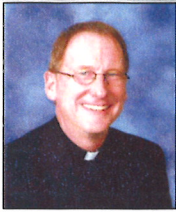

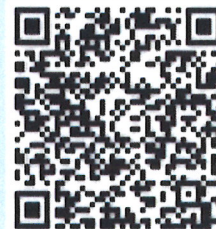

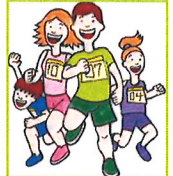


BAPTISM CLASS FOR PARENTS
