A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The missionary who was supposed to speak last weekend had an unexpected death in his family and had to cancel the trip to Fort Wayne. We will reschedule at a later date. We welcome this weekend presenters from Marriage Encounter. They will talk about an upcoming weekend to be held here at St. Charles. Marriage Encounter is a program designed for married couples to be very intentional about improving their sharing and communication with one another. The retreat weekend will be held on October 7 and 8.

I'm excited about an event we have scheduled on the evening of September 21. Don Clemmer is a parishioner and a member of our St. Charles parish council. 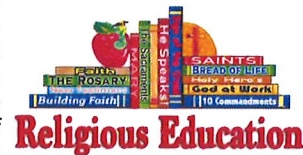

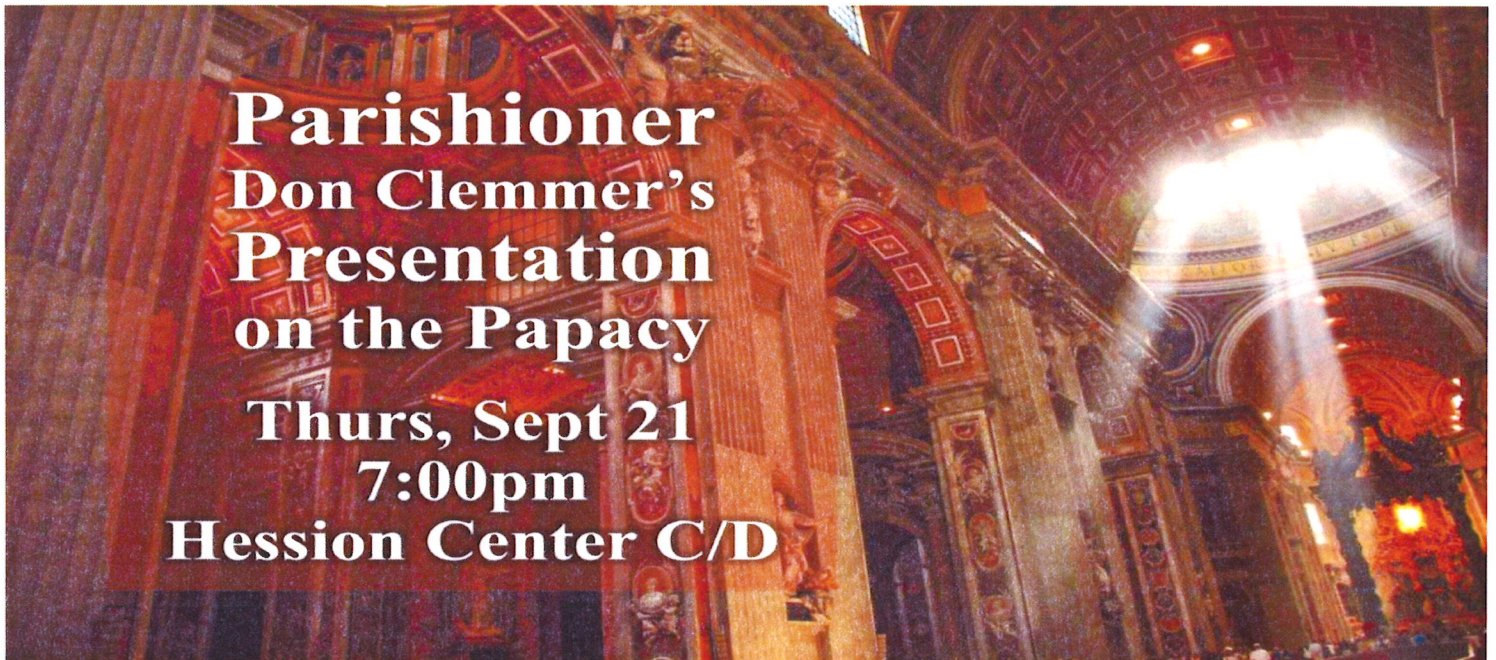

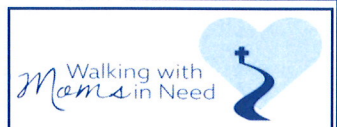
