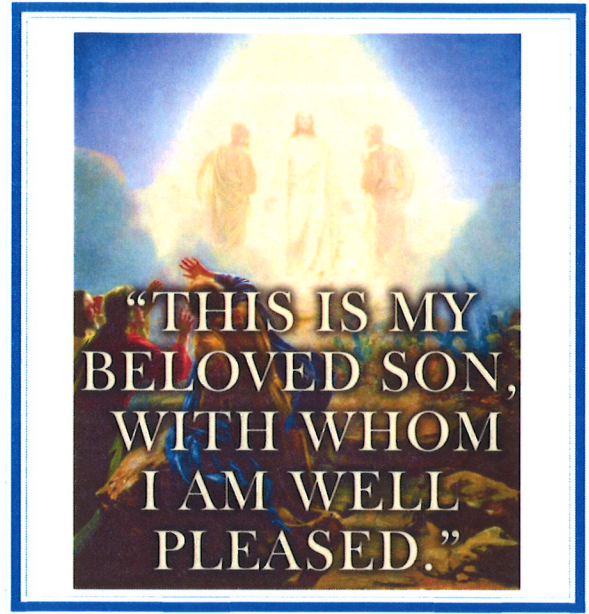

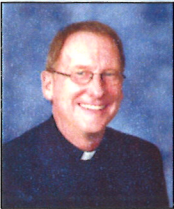

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

It is exciting to follow the progress of our World Youth Day Pilgrims in Portugal. The papal Mass will be this weekend, August 6. Our pilgrims will join hundreds of thousands of others in celebrating their Catholic faith with the pope. Monday should be their travel day home.

The photography is underway for the parish picture directory. As I write this column (a week in advance,) an extra day has been added to the schedule and there are still photography appointments available. If you haven't made an appointment, check and see if something is still open.

Our nursery will be closed this weekend and next as we use that space for photography for the parish picture directory. We have had a married couple who have organized the nursery since it opened in the spring. They need to pull back due to health issues, so we are now in need of more volunteers to watch the children and especially of someone to coordinate and schedule the volunteers. Please call the parish office if you would be able to help. It is a great service to families to provide care for their children while they attend Mass.

With the nursery closed, it is probably also a good time to mention something about the babies in our parish. I have covered Masses recently in two parishes where I haven't seen any babies and hardly any young children. I find that sad. It is a thrill and a joy to have so many little ones here at St. Charles. It is a sign of a vital parish and a parish filled with joy. I will point out to our young parents that we are equipped with speakers both in the Gathering Space and also in our Cry Room. Please bring your little ones to Mass. If they become distressed, it is easy to carry the child out until they are ready to return without missing anything.

St. Anne's Home is looking for volunteers to help with their Sunday morning Mass. They could use help in shuttling people in wheelchairs to and from the chapel. They could also use the help of an extraordinary minister to take Holy Communion to the rooms of residents who are not able to come to the chapel. 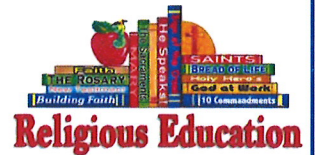

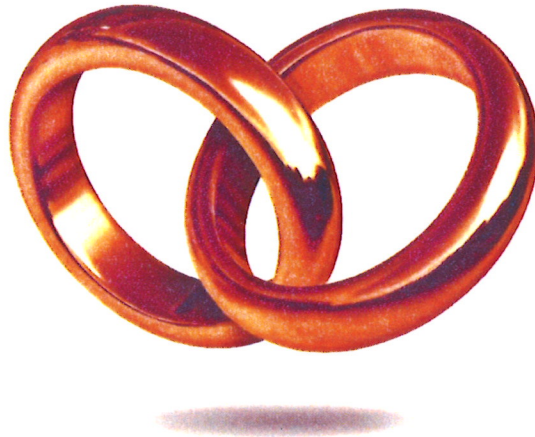
