**The St. Vincent DePaul Society**

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on **Monday, August 21**, at 7:00 p.m. in the **Hession Center, Room B**. Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If this is something that is important to you, please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

We have had a busy summer helping the needy in our community. During the months of June and July, we were able to help 283 individuals consisting of 141 adults and 142 children. We provided \$5,788 in rent and motel stays, \$5,393.79 in utility payments, \$575 in cards for gas and food, \$203 for furniture and household items and \$399 for food which provided 2100 pounds of food, \$532 for transportation, and \$94 for miscellaneous items. In addition, we gave \$200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help immigrant families. We spent a total of \$13,667 to help the needy.

Next weekend, we will have our annual **Stuff A Truck** event. The SVdP Store trucks will be in the parking lot at the corner of Trier and Reed on August 19 and 20 to accept donations of furniture in good condition, gently used clothing and household items. **The trucks will be available between the hours of 10 AM and 5 PM on Saturday and 12 PM and 5 PM on Sunday.** I hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to clean out closets and garages.

The St. Charles Maintenance Department is in need of cleaning rags. If you have some that you can spare, please bring them to the Charity Room in the next two weeks.

Only through your generosity have we been able to help so many. We are very grateful for your continued support. Thank you.

Did you know **SCRIP** has an app for your phone? RaiseRight is the name of the app that can be used to purchase e-gift cards and add funds to your reloadable gift cards. **E-gift cards** are digital gift cards that are delivered electronically and saved to your virtual wallet in minutes. Over 450 stores are available 24/7 and can easily be used for online shopping or scanned by the retailer at check-out in store. **Reloadable gift cards** are a physical gift card initially purchased from St. Charles which can be electronically reloaded with additional funds using the RaiseRight app or website. Reloadable cards save time, reduce waste, and are great for regular purchases to your favorite stores. There are over 150 reloadable gift cards available. Using the RaiseRight app requires a linked bank account and a special St. Charles code, so contact a **SCRIP** coordinator to get a handout with all the details.

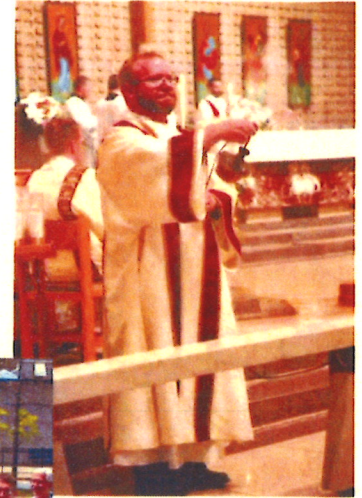

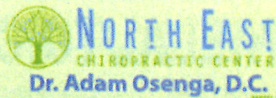
