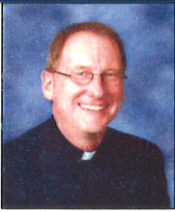

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We have finished our photography appointments for the parish picture directory and the response has been excellent. After filling the original 15 days for appointments, we added five more days. With 40 appointments per day, that is a lot of people.

If you missed the opportunity, we would still like to have you featured in the upcoming directory. For a charge of \$20, you can send us a photo. The photo will be included in the book and you will receive a directory when it is printed. The background and lighting won't be a match with the professional photos, but we aren't worried about that; we would like to have you and your family in the book. Photos can be sent electronically to my e-mail, fathertom@scbfw.org. If you would like to bring in a paper photo, we can scan it at the parish office and return it to you. Our deadline is September 3. We would like to have everyone who worships with us included in the book.

I also need to report how pleased I was with our Mass attendance for the Holy Day on August 15. Knowing that an all-school Mass is an overflowing crowd, we added a 12:30 Mass that day. We had crowds bigger than expected at all of our Masses. This is a great sign for the health of the Church. I offer thanks for all who take their faith so seriously.

Mark your calendar for a very interesting talk at 7:00 p.m. on September 21, in the Hession Center. Don Clemmer is a St. Charles parishioner who worked for several years for our US Bishops' Conference in Washington and who now writes for US Catholic and other publications. He will share with us some history of the modern papacy and also point out some of our newly-named cardinals along with insights about some of the high-profile cardinals who could some day be the next pope.

Bishop Rhoades is encouraging people to take part in the National Eucharistic Congress next summer in Indianapolis. SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of AUGUST & SEPTEMBER

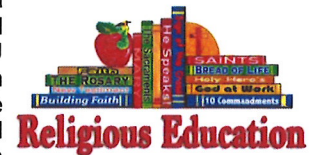
Sign-up book is located in the Gathering Space.

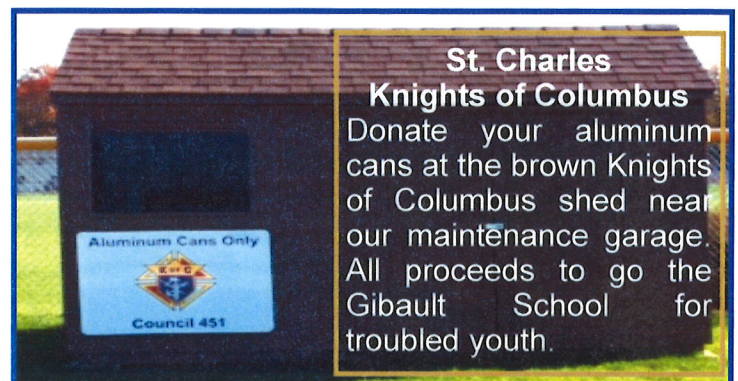

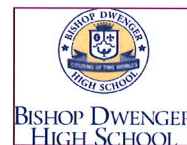
