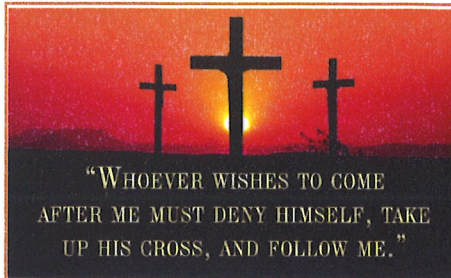

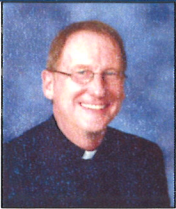

SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER



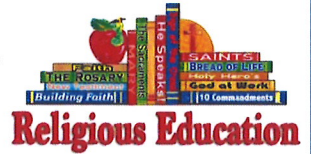
Sign-up book is located in the Gathering Space.

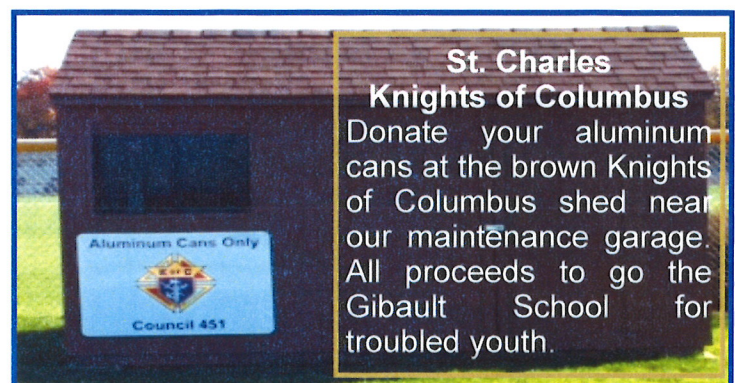

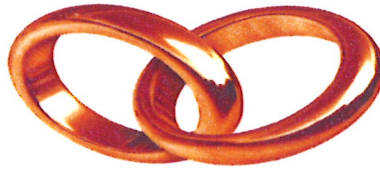

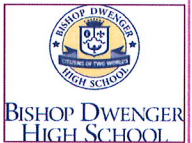
