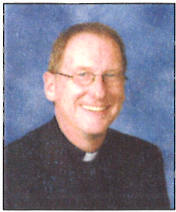

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

Next weekend is our parish festival, Cardinal Fest. After two years of pandemic restrictions, it is exciting to see our parish festival returning to full force. On Friday evening, we have a Hawaiian-themed teen dance with food and drinks.

Saturday is the main event. We will have food trucks, Bingo, indoor carnival games, outdoor inflatables, a cake decorating contest, a shop with cool things for kids to purchase, and lots of opportunities to spend fun time together in the afternoon and early evening. New this year: I have spent a few years constructing a chapel in our rectory. 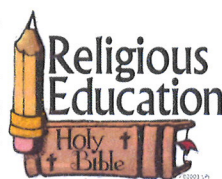
