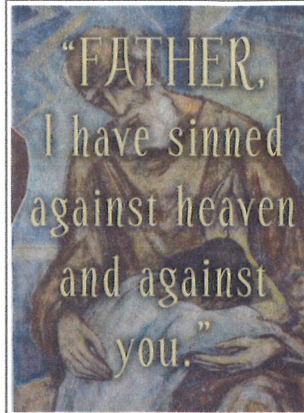

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

We thank everyone who has been involved in the Cardinal Fest activities this weekend. An enormous amount of planning and work takes place behind the scenes to make this festival happen, and we have some very talented organizers who have jumped in to help. We are most grateful to Stephanie Keefer and this year's committee.

We received this week a check from the estate of Patricia Madden and also a check from the estate of Sharon Shea. Both were parishioners who remembered the parish in their will. Please remember them in your prayer.

This Tuesday evening is the first of a series of *Catholic Faith Topics* which will be presented in the Hession Center at 7:00 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month. This should be a chance to learn more about the faith and to have some interesting discussion. Everyone is welcome.

RCIA meetings have also begun every Tuesday evening in the Parish Office basement. This is a series for those who are not Catholic, and particularly for those who are considering joining the Church. Call Casey Ryan at the parish office for information.

The Redeemer Radio Fall Sharathon is coming up soon. We will have a table in the back of church next weekend for anyone who would like to make a pledge in advance. Catholic radio has been an important presence in Fort Wayne. We are grateful for all of the parish support over the years.

Next weekend we will also introduce a campaign to raise funds for World Youth Day pilgrims. I think our count is now twenty-one parishioners, high school and young adult, who have begun plans for this trip. As you might guess, it is not inexpensive. This is a great way to encourage the faith lives of our young people.

Over the last couple of weeks we have had a lot of problems with our parish e-mail. I think that we are receiving e-mails as usual, but much of our outgoing mail is bouncing back. If you have tried to contact me or another staff member by e-mail and haven't had a response, don't give up on us. A telephone call may be a surer thing.



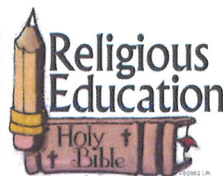




