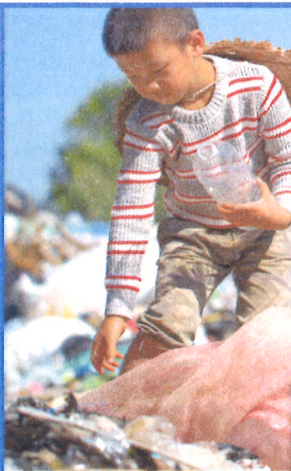

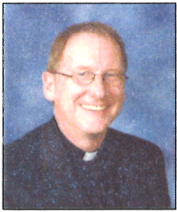

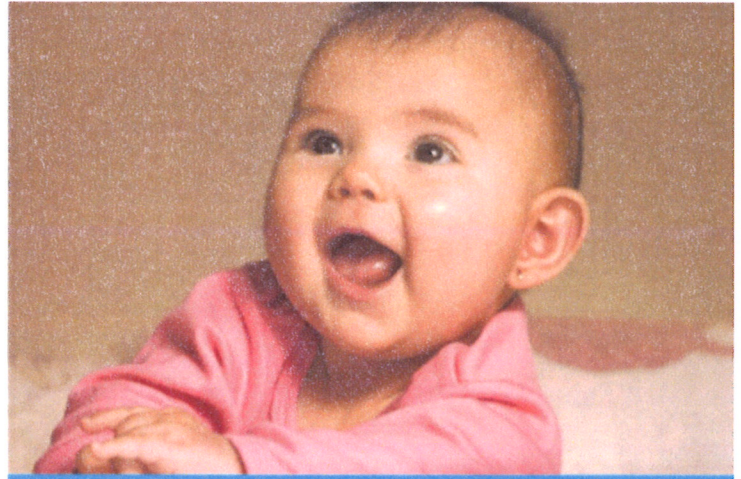

EUCCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE SITE FOR OCTOBER: ST.THERÈSE, LITTLE FLOWER PARISH, SOUTH BEND

Each month, you are invited to take a self-guided pilgrimage to a site of Eucharistic significance in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend. The October pilgrimage site is St. Thérèse, Little Flower Parish in South Bend, whose patron saint held a deep devotion to the Eucharist. The parish chapel has the only first-class relics of Saints Louis and Zélie Martin in North America, the parents of Saint Thérèse, who first taught her to love Jesus in the Eucharist. Pilgrims are invited to download a pilgrimage passport at diocesefwsb.org/eucharist and self "stamp" the passport each time you visit a site. OCTOBER MONTHLY EUCCHARISTIC SAINT

St. Thérèse of Lisieux (the "Little Flower") lived from 1873 to 1897, dying at only 24 years of age. She entered the Carmelite order at the age of 15 and became Directress of Novices in 1895. Known for her "little way" to holiness, she was canonized in 1925 and is a Doctor of the Church. In her autobiography, St. Thérèse expresses her joy after receiving Holy Communion: "It was a totally heavenly happiness which words cannot express. Also, "The best means to reach perfection is through receiving Holy Communion frequently. And "Do you realize that Jesus is there in the tabernacle expressly for you for you alone? He burns with the desire to come into your heart. Her feast day was Oct 1.
