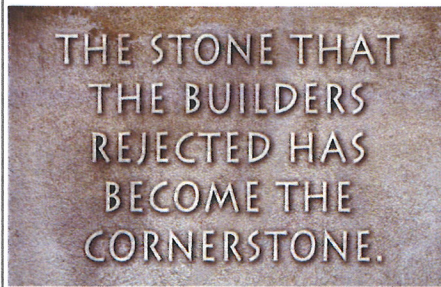

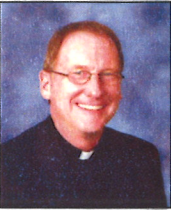

Our group will be celebrating Sunday Mass this weekend in the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem. We will remember the parish in our prayers as we ask for yours. We return Thursday night.

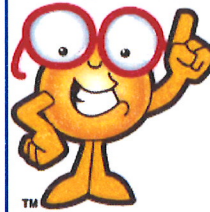


SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

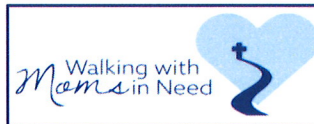
