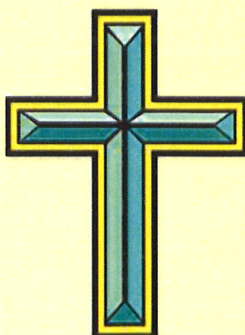

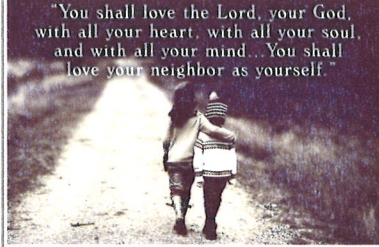

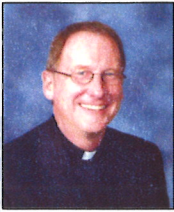

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Wednesday is the Feast of All Saints, a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have a Vigil Mass on Tuesday evening at 6:30 p.m. and Masses on Wednesday at 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Bishop Rhoades will be here for our parish Confirmation on Wednesday evening at 7:00 p.m. The Confirmation Mass will count for the

Holy Day Obligation and everyone is welcome, but please be aware that it will be longer than a usual parish Mass.

Thursday is the Feast of All Souls, a time when we pray especially for loved ones who have died. At the Thursday evening Mass, we will read the names of those who have had a St. Charles funeral since last November, lighting a candle in memory of each. Everyone is very welcome to this Mass at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday. If you have a loved one who has died in the last year but did not have a St. Charles funeral and you plan to come to this Mass, call us and we will add that name to our list. If you are not able to attend the Mass, you can join by livestream. Go to the parish website, stcharlesfortwayne.org, and click on the link.

Brother Marius Roy (formerly Austin Roy, the son of Jim and Cheryl,) is in formation at the Carthusian Monastery of the Transfiguration in Vermont. Novices are allowed to send out a letter twice a year, filling in family and friends on the news. Brother Marius notes that his two-year novitiate is near an end. In December he will take temporary vows and receive the habit of a professed Carthusian Brother. He will take a vow of Obedience, a vow of Conversion of Life, and a vow of Stability. The Carthusian vow of Stability is a promise to never leave the monastery, and in fact to remain in his own cell except for meals, liturgy, classes, and community events. We keep Brother Marius in prayer.

A plenary indulgence is available during the first week of November for those who offer prayers for the deceased in a cemetery. Several Masses will be offered at Catholic Cemetery. Bishop Rhoades will celebrate Mass there at noon on Nov. 2, I will have a Mass at 1:30 p.m. on Nov. 3, and other priests will offer Mass at 2:00 p.m. on Nov. 6 and 1:30 p.m. on Nov. 8. This is a chance to help the souls in purgatory.

I offer a word of thanks and congratulations to Barb Carey-North, who is retiring from our parish staff this week. Barb has been working in our business office for many years. Peggy Lehn and Judy Smith are both taking positions in the parish office. We welcome them.

Next weekend, we will celebrate the Feast Day of St. Charles Borromeo. We ask that he will bless our parish with his prayers from heaven.

You can also switch to a different organization and then continue to purchase **SCRIP** online. You will need to have the program's code in order to do this. Sign-in at RaiseRight.com (not the app, but same login), select Account, then Settings, and choose a different organization.
