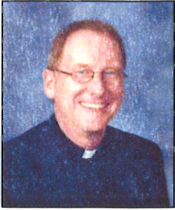

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Thanksgiving comes this week. This is a civic holiday and not a Church feast, however, it is an opportune time for all of us to reflect on the faith. Food, family, parades and football are all good, but we don't want to leave the "thanksgiving" out of Thanksgiving. It is a day to turn to God in prayer. We have just one Mass on Thanksgiving

Day, Thursday at 8:15 a.m.


On Tuesday evening at 7:00 p.m., we are invited to an interfaith Thanksgiving service at the Jewish Temple, Achduth Vesholom, at 5200 Old Mill Road. Last year a number of St. Charles parishioners attended this service, which included prayers, music, poetry, and thoughts from Jewish, Baha'i, Buddhist, and Christian leaders. Our parish has made a contribution and we are one of the official sponsors of the event this year. In a world in which religious and ethnic tensions are so high, it is surely good to get to know our neighbors and even to pray together.

A reminder of our parish evening retreat: On Monday evening, November 27, a group of young Damascus Missionaries will be here at St. Charles to provide an evening retreat. They will lead us in prayer, offer witness talks, offer quiet time for Adoration, and stir our faith. The event will take place in the church, beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending by 8:30 p.m. We are about to enter Advent and the month of December, and most of us find that our lives too busy and hectic to spend enough time focused on God. Here is a time for that focus. Everyone is welcome. [Note: Because of the parish retreat, we will not have a 6:30 p.m. Mass on Monday, Nov. 27.]

You may have noticed two round concrete pads just installed next to our softball field fence. These will be surrounded by low fencing and serve as gaga ball pits. For those who aren't familiar: gaga ball is something like dodgeball. The game involves players jumping and dodging while swatting a ball at each other's legs and trying to prevent the ball from hitting one's own legs. It isn't a sport which will earn anyone a college scholarship or a spot on an Olympic team, but it is fun and great exercise.

To those who have, much will be given. Count your blessings. Give them away.






BORROMEO BASH

Dear Friend of St. Charles Borromeo Parish & School,

We are pleased to announce that the 6th annual Borromeo Bash will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2024 at Ceruti's. This past February, as a school and parish community, we gathered together for a delightful evening of food and fellowship, while successfully raising over \$72,000. Thank you to all, who through your generosity and kindness, have continued to support the needs of our school's students, faculty, staff and all our parishioners!

Borromeo Bash, through your kindness, has raised approximately \$385,000 over the past five years. We have also been blessed that many of our planned projects utilized matching funds or additional grants from an influx of State and/or Federal funds received during the Covid years. This unforeseen funding led to projects being completed at lower than expected costs to the parish. The computer lab, improved security system, high efficiency lighting, and more - all would not have been possible without the Borromeo Bash. Instead of spending frivolously, the Borromeo Bash Committee held onto the funds until we could properly channel money towards other needed projects - for instance, after an unforeseen delay last year, new school windows are finally in the works!

Our current BB balance sits at just over \$235,000, of which, with additional funds from BB 2024 in February, we hope to put \$250,000 towards the school window replacement project, then turn further attention and proceeds towards a school restroom refreshing/renovation. As good stewards of your generosity, we are committed to helping the school and Parish grow with an eye towards the future.

Fr. Tom has contracted with MARTINRILEY architects - engineers (MRae) to replace all the circa 1970s curtain wall systems with a modern and more energy-efficient wall system. We would like to increase the amount of vision glass within each classroom and have at least one operable window for egress in each classroom. The preliminary construction budget range, based upon previous proposals, will run from \$600,000 - \$900,000 for all windows replaced along the main hallway from the office to the end of junior high. The proposed schedule of work and deadlines for the Window Replacement/Façade Update are as follows:

- Field Work and Data Collection Mid-October 2023 - *Begun*
- Schematic Design with Owner Early November 2023
- 90% Review with Owner Early December 2023
- Construction Documents 100% Complete Late December 2023
- Invitation to Bid Early January 2024
- Pre-Bid Meeting Mid-January 2024
- Bid Opening Late January 2024
- Construction Start Beginning Summer Break 2024
- Construction Substantially Complete End of Summer Break 2024




