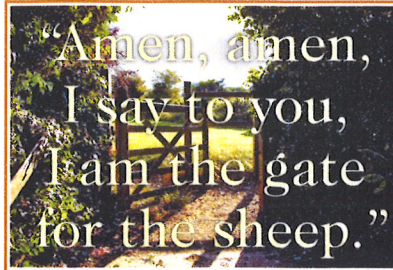

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Today has been designated a World Day of Prayer for Vocations. The Church is in need of more priestly vocations and more vocations to religious life and we need more focus on young men and women who may hear the call to be a priest or religious. St. Charles is the patron saint of seminarians, and our daily parish vocation prayer is an important part of our parish life. I

think that we also need to focus our prayer on other vocations of service, and maybe on married life in particular. I note with some alarm that the number of weddings at St. Charles has been markedly declining in recent years. Despite strong numbers of baptisms and funerals, we are seeing less young adults willing to make a sacred life commitment in marriage. Let's keep that in prayer as well.

The seminarians from our diocese have received their summer assignments. Only a handful of our seminarians will be assigned to parishes this summer, and we won't have one assigned at St. Charles. Our parish seminarians, Sam Martinez and Noah Isch, will both be assigned in South Bend, at St. Anthony and St. Adalbert Parishes. Our other parish seminarian, Deacon Jake Schneider, has only a week or two left in the seminary and will soon be receiving an assignment as a parish priest. His ordination is June 3.

With blooming flowers, chirping birds, and green trees, May is surely the most beautiful month of the year. We dedicate this most beautiful month to Mary, Our Mother. We will hold a parish May crowning at 1:30 p.m. on Monday, May 8. As our school children sing the traditional May crowning hymns, a crown of flowers will be placed on our statue of the Blessed Mother. On May 13, the musical group *Ecce* will host an event at Catholic Cemetery at 1:00 p.m., honoring the Blessed Mother with classical Marian music and a rosary. This month may also be good time to offer a family rosary or to set up a May altar in the home. Some families put a statue or a picture of Our Lady in a prominent place in the home and keep flowers and candles there during the month as a place for prayer.

Next Sunday, May 7, we will have our parish First Communion Mass at 1:00 p.m. This is an important day in the lives of our young parishioners. Please keep them in prayer.

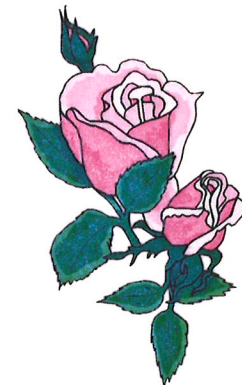

O BEAUTIFUL MOTHER

On **Saturday, May 13**, from 1:00 p.m.-2:15 p.m., the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, we are teaming up with Fr. Daniel Whelan at Catholic Cemetery here in Fort Wayne (3500 Lake Avenue) for an event called "O Beautiful Mother". We will be gathering at the cemetery's outdoor Marian grotto for hymns and prayers to honor our Blessed Mother on this day before Mother's Day, and to pray for all our mothers, living and deceased.



Here's the article that Today's Catholic published about O Beautiful Mother last year! <https://todayscatholic.org/o-beautiful-mother-honors-mary-all-mothers/> At the beginning of the event, we will be praying the rosary, and we are recruiting children in grades K-12 from the surrounding parishes to lead the prayers! Next to the Marian grotto, there are shrubs planted in the shape of a rosary, with one shrub for each rosary bead. The plan is to have one child standing at each of the "beads," ready to lead their Our Father, Hail Mary, or Glory Be when their turn comes. We know that even memorized prayers can be hard to lead in front of others, so we will have a written copy of the prayers there for the kids to read from.

If your child(ren) are interested in helping to lead the rosary prayers, please email me at jesscia.schuster.155@gmail.com or text/call me at (419) 266-2496, reserve your child's "bead," and receive further instructions. At least one parent or guardian must be present throughout the full duration of the event, and I'd ask that rosary leaders arrive at the cemetery 20 minutes ahead of time. In case of rain, we will relocate indoors to the Resurrection Mausoleum on site.
