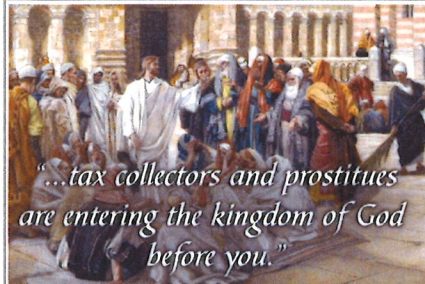

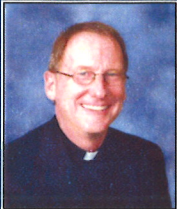

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We are honored this weekend to welcome Brother Jacob Eifrid, CSC. Brother Jacob, the son of Joe and Maria Eifrid and a member of our parish, recently took his final vows as a Holy Cross Brother. As our parish has been offering a prayer for vocations for many years, we see the fruits of that prayer. Brother Jacob will be here for the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses this weekend and we will have a reception after both of those Masses in the Hession Center.

It is time again for the Annual Bishop's Appeal. We are showing the Bishop's video before each Mass begins and we will have pledge cards in the pews. We welcome all pledges, and we encourage everyone to fill out a pledge card. You may drop it in the collection basket or send it to the parish office over the next couple of weeks. You may also opt to make a donation to the appeal online. Go to www.diocesefwsb.org/aba.

It has been more than two years since we have offered the Precious Blood at Communion in our parish. That practice, of course, was eliminated when the pandemic began. Now that the dangerous phase of COVID seems to be behind us, many parishes are again offering Holy Communion under both species. We are planning to offer both species beginning next weekend—only at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses, and only at the center aisle. We will evaluate how things are going and expand our list of extraordinary ministers before expanding to more aisles and more Masses. The Roman Missal tells us that Holy Communion was offered under both species for the first thousand years of our Church history, and it is "a fuller sign of the Eucharistic banquet." However, make no mistake—we receive the very presence of Jesus in either the Body or the Blood of Christ. It is a totally acceptable practice to receive just one species.

I will be leaving on Monday morning with a group of parishioners for a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. We will offer prayer for this parish from the very sites where Jesus walked. We will return late on October 12. You are in good hands with Fr. James, Fr. Bobby and our parish staff.

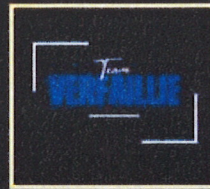
