A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR . . .

At Monday's Masses, we will celebrate for the first time the Memorial of Blessed Solanus Casey. Blessed Solanus was a Capuchin priest who lived in Huntington from 1946 to 1956. He was ordained a *simplex priest*; because he did poorly in the seminary he wasn't given permission to hear confessions or to preach at Mass. He was known, though, for his humility, his wisdom, and his holiness of life, and miracles were attributed to his intercession. Blessed Father Solanus died and was buried at the Capuchin friary in Detroit, where there is now a beautiful shrine.

On Thursday, an interesting event is taking place at St. Charles, Porziuncula Day. The *porziuncula* is the tiny chapel outside of Assisi in which St. Francis began organizing the Franciscan order and the Poor Claires. This day is a remembrance of all Franciscan orders and the gift they have been to the Church. Our local Order of Penitents along with our Friars Minor are organizing an afternoon of prayer, food and games, beginning at 4 p.m. and ending at 7:30. Confessions will be heard throughout the afternoon in the chapel and the Mass will be offered twice, at 4:00 and again at 6:30. An indulgence is offered to those who attend Mass and receive Communion, go to confession, and offer an Our Father, Hail Mary and Creed for the intentions of Pope Francis.

We are not quite done with our new seating in the chapel. A parishioner is making matching kneeling rails to place in front of the end seats on row two and we are having seat cushions made. I am pleased that our old chairs have found a good home. Sacred Heart Parish, on the southeast side of Fort Wayne, will be using them behind the pews in the back of their church.
