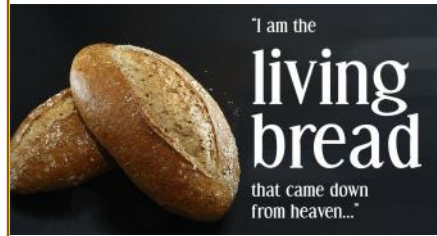

As they are completed, the new classroom windows and shelving are a huge improvement in the school rooms. The look from the outside is also a major improvement.

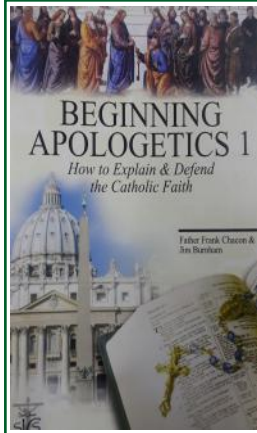
ST. MONICA PRAYER GROUP EVERY TUESDAY, 6:00 P.M.

PARISH CHILDREN'S CHOIR BEGINS SOON

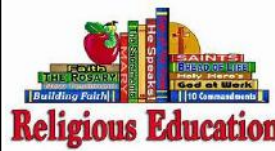
The Parish Children's Choir begins the new season soon and all children of the parish grades 1-6 are welcome!

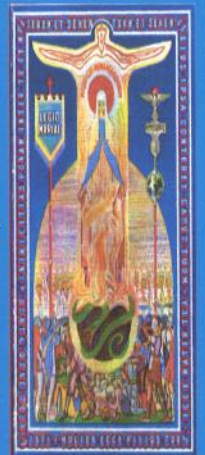
