



A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The life of a good steward is a life of sharing whatever gifts we are given. We can't be self-centered; we must see our blessings and help those who need help. In light of that vision, our parish distributes an annual tithe. We are giving 10% of our offertory collection to parishes in need and to ministries which could use help. We have a list of 15 different good causes which are receiving part of our annual tithe.

This year, we are also giving some large one-time gifts. You will recall that our parish recently received an enormous bequest. A family, who wishes to remain anonymous, left us over \$9 million. We tithed on the first installment of that bequest last winter. We are now completing our tithe, giving 10% to good causes. With recommendations from the Bishop and with a committee of parishioners who offered research and advice, we are giving the following one-time gifts:

\$300,000 Our Lady of Hungary Parish in South Bend

\$ 50,000 Queen of Angels Parish, FW (in addition to our annual tithe of \$20,000)

\$ 50,000 St. John Parish, South Bend

\$ 30,000 St. Ann's Home, FW to help install a hearing loop in the chapel

\$ 25,000 Fr. James' monastery in India

\$ 15,000 Catechetical Center in Uganda

\$ 10,000 Rose Home, FW

\$ 8,000 Inasmuch Ministry, FW

5,000 Ave Maria House, FW

\$ 4,000 St. Mary Seminary, Uganda (in addition to our annual tithe of \$13,000)

\$ 3,000 MISFITS Ministry, FW

CONCERT FOR ORGAN AND CLARINET AT THE CATHEDRAL


All are cordially invited to attend a concert for organ and clarinet at The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on Friday, November 22, at 7:30 PM.


