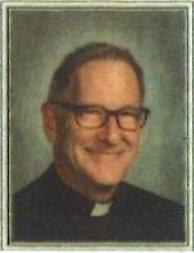

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



We have begun Advent. This is a time of prayer and reflection, awaiting the coming of Christ. In the midst of all of the December activity, let's not lose focus.

Next weekend, we will have our annual collection to help retired religious. Sister Rose Clare Ehrlich will offer some words about that collection and we will pass the basket twice at Mass. Our parish has been very well served by religious sisters

through the years. This is our chance to help them in their retired years.

An interesting meeting will take place at St. Charles this week. On Monday, Dec. 2, at 7:00 p.m., a speaker will join us in the Community Room (off of the Gathering Space) to talk about the vision of building a Catholic home for the dying in Fort Wayne. She will also give us an overview of a training program for Spiritual Companions for the dying. A Spiritual Companion is a person who would volunteer to spend time with a dying person, to pray with them, and simply to be a loving presence. Please join us Monday evening if you might like to learn more about either project.

Our Advent Giving Tree is set up in the Gathering Space. You are invited to take a card from the tree and return it next weekend with a gift. This week's gifts will benefit St. Patrick's Pantry.

On Saturday morning, December 7, Fr. Bobby will celebrate an early morning Mass at 6:45 a.m., called a *Rorate Caeli* Mass. There is a tradition which comes from Bavaria of celebrating an early morning Mass during Advent in honor of the Blessed Mother. The Mass begins in a dark church lit only with candles. It ends as the sun is coming up. Everyone is welcome to join us for that early Mass and a donut after.

A word about the upcoming Holy Day: December 8 is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. This year December 8 falls on a Sunday. Holy Days of Obligation usually take the place of a Sunday Mass, but that isn't the case during Advent. Therefore, our Holy Day of Obligation has been moved to Monday, December 9. We will have four Masses on December 9: 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., 12:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. The 5:00 p.m. Sunday evening Mass next weekend will be the Advent Sunday Mass. That Mass, however, could count for the Mass obligation for either the Sunday or the Holy Day but not both. In other words: Next weekend, as always, we need to attend Mass either Saturday evening or Sunday. Then we need to attend a second Mass either Sunday evening or Monday.

Please offer an extra prayer for the second graders of our parish who will take part in their First Reconciliation on Saturday. This is an important day in their lives.

During the month of October, 2024, we were able to help 220 individuals consisting of 109 adults and 111 children. We provided \$30 in bus passes, \$125 auto repair, \$323 in food equating to 1700 pounds, \$250 in gift cards for gas and food, \$73 medical/prescription, \$110 for household items, \$675 for furniture, \$300 thrift store, \$1,805 in rent and \$823 mortgage, \$336 other, \$3,196 in utility payments, \$300 partnering with local Parishes, and \$200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish. SVdP St Charles spent a total of \$8,546 to help the needy in the community.

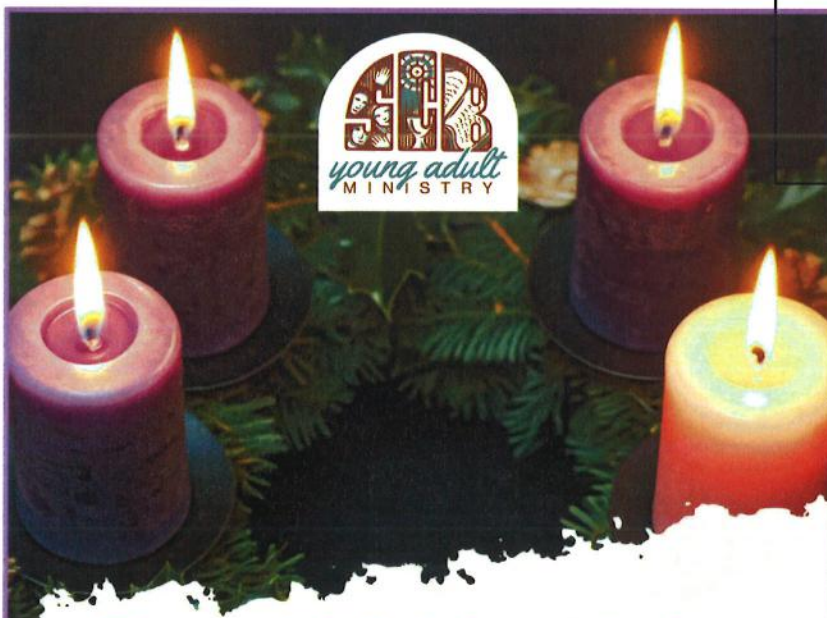

Seven months ago, our St. Charles Borromeo School & Parish Community gathered together for a delightful evening of food and fellowship and successfully raised over \$80,000 bringing our six-year total to just over \$450,000 raised. With this funding, we have been able to support the ministries of our Parish & School, financially assisting with needed improvements, program funding, and various initiatives to keep our community safe and vibrant!

Over the summer, BB funding helped with two long-awaited projects. The first was the successful renovation of our school's original 3rd through 8th grade restrooms - new flooring, partitions, paint, etc. They look great! Our second, larger school project, which began in June, is the replacement of all the windows, also original, in the 23 classrooms encompassing grades 3 through 8. This project has five phases with a target completion date of February 22nd. The first phase, which was the southern exposure of the junior high wing, has completely transformed the exterior of the school and brought much needed light and modern design to the interior classrooms. 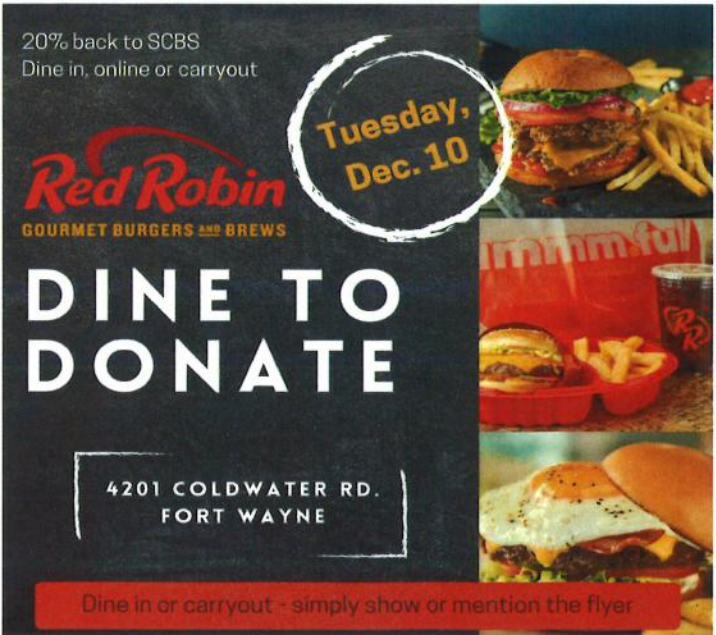

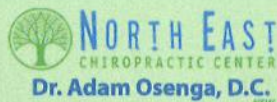
