

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



I begin the new year by offering a word of thanks to all in this parish. This is a very generous parish. We see that in the tithing and offertory donations, the volunteer hours given in the church and in the school, the number of people jumping in to help with parish activities, the donations for our Advent Giving Tree and our special collections, and the people stepping up to help one another.

We are blessed with a generous parish. And that generosity is evidence of strong faith.

We are receiving letters of thanks for all of the generosity of our parish in helping those in need. This from St. Patrick's Food Pantry: "Please convey to your parishioners our utmost gratitude for their generosity to our Food Pantry. We are so incredibly grateful for the generosity outpoured."

I have given many times a presentation about Church history called "Pope on a Rope." I'm going to offer that presentation at St. Vincent's on Tuesday evening, 1/7 at 7:00 p.m. in the church. Anyone who would like to join us is welcome. I'll be offering it again at St. Charles on a Saturday morning in March, sponsored by our apologetics group.

An item which I find humorous: Divine Mercy Funeral Home generously donated the 2025 Catholic calendars which we gave away before Christmas. When September rolls around, you may be perplexed by the picture in the calendar. The photo shows a tray of small plastic cups, such as many Protestant churches use for distributing communion. Someone at the calendar company goofed. As Catholics, we would never put the Sacred Blood of Christ into disposable plastic cups which can't be purified and would be thrown away after Mass. Oops. Skip the September picture and it is a great calendar.

Another curious item: I was recently given a medal and holy card which identify St. Charles Borromeo as the Patron Saint of those who are dieting. That's right....Dieting. I am not sure why. We have portraits of St. Charles and he doesn't look overweight. He was known for feeding the hungry in times of famine, but I don't know that he ever started a Weight Watchers group. In any event, we may want to ask for his help especially after Christmas. Knowing that St. Charles is the Patron Saint of Seminarians, we offer a vocation prayer at the end of every Mass. Maybe during the month after Christmas we should substitute a St. Charles prayer for dieters!

St. Charles Borromeo School Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration

St. Charles Borromeo School Pre-K4 and Kindergarten registration day is Wednesday, January 15. Registration will be held in the

afternoon from 1:15 p.m. - 2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m - 7:00 p.m. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school in the church parking lot and enter through door # 3 near the gym. If unable to attend, please call the school office (260-484 -3392) to arrange for an alternate registration day.

Kindergarten: For this coming school year 2025-2026, full-day Kindergarten is available with a classroom size limit of 24 students per class with an aide assisting the teacher. The school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If needed, for an additional fee, BeforeCare and AfterCare service is available for all students. The registration fee of \$50 is included in the overall tuition costs and is not a required payment at this time.

Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program: We offer five-day Pre-K4 classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-Day). Our morning program runs from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program runs from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. A separate \$50 Pre-K registration fee is required.


