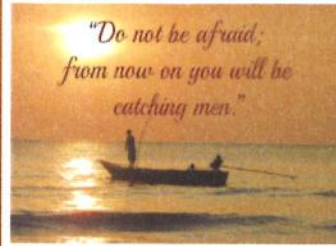

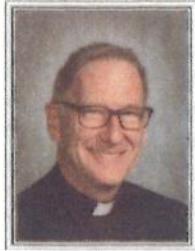

We are going to offer a new prayer opportunity at St. Charles this Lent. We are a parish committed to the mission of our parish school.
