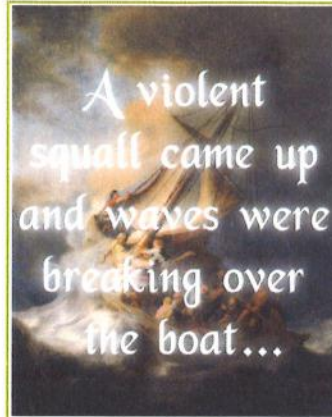

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



It is required that priests spend time away from their ministry on retreat each year. Fr. James will attend the Diocesan Priest Retreat this week and be away from Monday through Friday. Fr. Bobby and I will both have retreat opportunities later in the year and we will maintain our normal schedule of Masses and Confessions in the parish.

It is exciting to see the progress on our school window project. When we are finished, the building will look much better, rooms will be brighter, our heating and cooling bills will drop, and we will have a fire escape in each room. It is, however, a very big job, which won't be finished until after Christmas. While work is underway, there will be four classrooms at a time which aren't available. We are planning at this point to rent portable classrooms which will be placed on the south side of the school, between the cafeteria and the Hession Center. Our school has a history of using portable classrooms when the building wasn't big enough. This will bring back memories for many.

As part of the Eucharistic Renewal, four Eucharistic Processions are now winding their way toward Indianapolis from each direction in our country. The processions will meet in Indianapolis for the beginning of the Eucharistic Congress on July 17. The northern procession begins at the far north of Minnesota and will pass through Fort Wayne. On Monday, July 8, the procession will progress from Immaculate Conception Parish in Auburn to St. Vincent in Fort Wayne. On Tuesday, July 9, it will pass from St. Vincent to St. Francis Xavier in Pierceton. Everyone is invited to take part in some of this procession. Check the diocesan website, diocesefwsb.org, as more details are posted. I believe that there are also tickets still available for the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, July 17-20. You can buy a one-day pass or a pass for the entire event. This will be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity.

We provided \$ 5,523 in rent and motel stays, \$ 728 in utility payments, \$ 515 in cards for gas and food, \$ 175 for furniture and household items, and \$ 209 for food which provided 1100 pounds of food, Transportation \$ 151, Other Assist \$ 421, Miscellaneous Items \$ 950 including \$ 200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help immigrant families. We spent a total of \$ 8,672 to help the needy.

Only through your generosity have we been able to help so many. We are very grateful for your continued support.
