A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The National Eucharistic Congress will take place beginning on July 17, in Indianapolis. I don't know how many parishioners will be attending, but we do have a large group of young adults, including Fr. Bobby.

For those of us who can't travel to the Congress. there is still an exciting way to be involved. Four

processions are now underway, carrying the Blessed Sacrament across the United States. (You can watch the progress on our diocesan website.) The four will meet on July 17 in Indianapolis. The northern procession, which began at the headwaters of the Mississippi in northern Minnesota, will be passing through Fort Wayne this week.

On Monday evening, July 8, that procession will land at St. Vincent Parish in Fort Wayne. Everyone is welcome to join from 7:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m. for Adoration and testimonials by some of the pilgrims who are spending the summer making the entire pilgrimage. For those who would like to take part as a St. Charles group, we'll meet in our parking lot at 6:30 p.m. and drive to St. Vincent.

There are other opportunities to take part: On Tuesday morning, July 9, Bishop Rhoades will offer Mass at St. Vincent at 7:30 a.m., followed by a short procession around the St. Vincent property. For those who would like to walk in a serious procession, at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, July 8, a 10-mile procession will leave from St. Michael in Waterloo and walk to Immaculate Conception Parish in Auburn. On Tuesday, July 9, an 8-mile procession will leave from St. Francis Xavier Parish in Pierceton at 10:00 a.m. and walk to Sacred Heart Parish in Warsaw. For those walking in the long processions, we are asked to register on the diocesan website and to be sure to bring water, comfortable shoes, and a hat for the sun.

It is our goal to reaffirm our faith in the Eucharist and to offer a witness to our nation.






