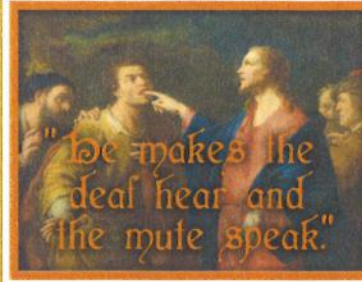

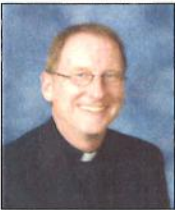

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We offer thanks to the great crew of volunteers who have made Cardinal Fest a reality this year. With our school construction and portable classrooms, it took some creativity to figure out how to make it work. We have a great crew. Thank you.

The Annual Bishop's Appeal is almost upon us. Next weekend, we will show the video before Mass begins and we will have pledge cards available in the pews. The appeal is nothing new....We are all familiar with this drive and with the important causes funded through the appeal. We are helping with seminarian tuition, income for retired priests, diocesan youth and young adult retreats, the administration for our Catholic schools, and many, many other important causes. Please be generous.

Though it may seem slow, work is progressing on our school window project. We have had delays in waiting for materials that have to be ordered and we have also had delays due to confusion on the variety of permits and approvals needed from government inspectors. We are making progress and we're excited about the results we can see so far.

You may also see that we have begun renovation on our youth house. The old convent was built in 1962, with nine bedrooms and living space for our sisters. The building is now used for youth and young adult ministries, with the Knights of Columbus, Shema Culture, and *Walking with Moms in Need* also using space in the building. As our Youth Ministry has grown, the meeting spaces aren't large enough. We are beginning by expanding the main meeting room, bricking in the back porch. We will then turn to upgrades in the kitchen and bathrooms with ideas of expanding the chapel and other meeting spaces as well.

Finally, a word of thanks for all of the prayers, cards and greetings following my surgery. My recovery has been much faster and easier than expected. I am grateful especially for those who have helped with their prayers.

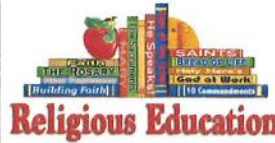
ARE YOU INTERESTED IN INTERNET BROADCASTING AND TECHNOLOGY


