

### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


I offer an enormous thanks to our Cardinal Fest organizers and volunteers. We had perfect weather, a great crowd, and a very fine event this year. It is important for the parish to have fun together. I enjoyed watching the kids running from game to game, collecting bags full of candy. I was also very impressed by the cleanup crew. I

went out to check early on Sunday morning and our property was spotless.

Sister Genevieve belongs to the Franciscan Sisters of the Sacred Heart. This spring she was elected to the leadership team in her community, and as things have evolved it has become apparent that her duties with the order are going to require her to move to the Mother House in Illinois. This week, she is leaving for Brazil to visit with the sisters who minister there. When she returns, she will begin packing and organizing her move back to Illinois. This will be a sad departure for our parish. The Franciscan Sisters have been in our parish since the school first opened in 1958 and the order doesn't have more sisters to send. Sister Genevieve herself has been in our school for 42 years, serving as a teacher, co-principal, and assistant principal. She will be greatly missed. We will recognize Sister Genevieve as we offer a farewell at the 8:15 a.m. school Mass on October 4-the Feast of St. Francis. We will also offer a reception with coffee and donuts after the three morning Masses on Sunday, October 6.

- 1. <u>What is the Annual Bishop's Appeal?</u> The Annual Bishop's Appeal is an important annual fund for the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend. The donations received help fund various ministries, programs and services.
- 2. What is the best way to give? Giving online at diocesefwsb.org/aba is a more secure method and also saves processing time for parish and diocesan staff. You can also scan this QR code to give online. If giving online, please do not submit a pledge card, as this creates a duplicate pledge.



- 3. What if I cannot give at this time? Please still send in your pledge card marking it with a zero. A completed pledge card will save parish follow-up letters and telephone calls.
- 4. <u>How do I return my pledge card?</u> You can mail your pledge card in the return envelope provided, drop it in the offertory collection basket at Mass, or drop off at the parish office.
- 5. <u>How do I make payments on my pledge?</u> Monthly statements/reminders will be sent out by the Diocesan Business Office for 10 months, December to September. All checks should be made out to the "Annual Bishop's Appeal" and returned to the diocese in the return envelope provided, not to the parish.
- 6. What if our parish reaches its goal? Any money collected in excess of our goal will be returned to the Parish to use as needed.


