A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The Annual Bishop's Appeal is now underway. I thank everyone in advance for the generous response of this parish in this important appeal. Pledges can be made online using the QR code or diocesan website, diocesefwsb.org. You may also turn in a pledge card found in the church. Goals for the appeal are increased this year


because of the shortage in our priest retirement funds. Four diocesan priests retired this year and the retirement fund has taken a hit. Our parish goal this year was raised from \$ 235,000 to \$ 266,000. Please be generous.

The St. Vincent de Paul Society is hosting the Annual *Walk for the Poor* on Sunday afternoon this weekend. Donations designated to someone in our parish will be used by our parish society to help local people in need.

A curious story: One night last week, someone left a box outside our chapel doors containing the cremated ashes of a deceased person. While it was a surprise, I am pleased that the ashes were brought here to the church. They will be properly buried with prayer at Catholic Cemetery.

I offer a few words about cremated remains. Our Catholic belief is that our body is holy, made by God. We believe too, in a resurrection of the body. At the end of time, tombs will be opened and bodies will be resurrected to be reunited with the souls in heaven. Therefore, the body should be treated with great respect after death. When a body is cremated, we should treat the ashes in the same way we would treat a body in a casket. The ashes should be kept intact and either buried or placed in a mausoleum niche. There are practices which are popular in our culture today which are just not fitting: scattering ashes over a lake or a garden, keeping an urn of ashes on the mantle in the home, and even making keepsakes and jewelry with human ashes. If you do have human ashes at your home, you are very welcome to bring them to the parish or to Divine Mercy Funeral Home at Catholic Cemetery. We will be sure that they are buried in a fitting manner with prayer and with reverence.

Over the coming month, the Priests from St. Charles will be covering a series of Masses in Churubusco and Ege. Priests who live alone have a hard time finding replacements to cover their Masses so that they can get away for vacation. With three priests in our parish, we are glad to help when we can.

During the month of August, 2024, we were able to help 162 individuals consisting of 108 adults and 54 children. We provided \$ 323.05 auto assistance, \$ 336 in bus passes, \$ 277 providing 1458 pounds of food, \$ 450 in gift cards for gas and food, \$ 1,020 for motel stays, \$ 38.45 for household items, \$ 227.37 for general items, \$ 1,070 for furniture and household items, \$ 3,720.65 in rent, \$ 3,521.37 in utility payments, \$ 300 partnering with local Parishes, and \$ 200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish. SVdP St Charles spent a total of \$ 11,483.89 to help the needy in the community.


