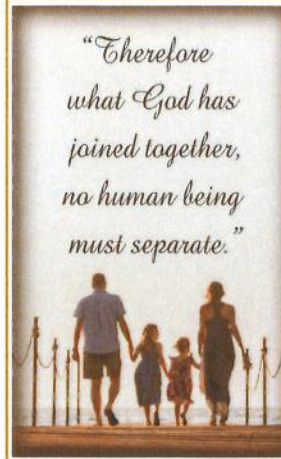

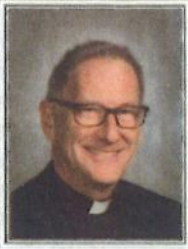

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



This is the weekend in which we bid a farewell to Sister Genevieve. Sister has served in our parish school for 42 years and has been a wonderful presence in our parish as well as a friend to many of us. We will miss her. Those who are here for Sunday morning Masses, please join us in the school cafeteria for coffee and donuts as we thank Sister and offer prayers for her in her new assignment.

We are blessed to have two religious sisters and two diocesan hermits who are members of our parish, but Sister Genevieve is the last of a long line of Franciscan Sisters assigned to ministry in our parish. We continue to pray for more vocations to the religious life. It would be wonderful to have more young women follow a call to live as a religious sister. We continue our prayer for vocations.

On the topic of vocations: Nick Monnin was ordained a deacon for our diocese in Rome on Thursday. Deacon Nick has been studying at a seminary in Rome and the ordination took place in St. Peter's Basilica. Unfortunately, I couldn't attend. However, I do have some bragging rights: As a young priest in South Bend, I married his parents. A couple of years later, I baptized him. He will be ordained a priest in June.

Bishop Rhoades is in Rome for the month of October, taking part in Pope Francis' Synod on Synodality. Last year he came home enthusiastic about his experience. I'll be anxious to hear how things go this year. We keep the synod in prayer.

Next weekend, we will have our Annual Outdoor Rosary event in the parking lot on the corner of Trier and Reed. We will pray all four sets of mysteries of the rosary, asking for Mary's intercession. In case of rain, we will move inside. Everyone is welcome to join us. Bring a folding chair and a rosary. We begin at noon.

Every year the diocese provides some days of education for our priests. All of us will be at Pokagon from the evening of October 15 until noon on October 17. A notice in advance: we will have no parish Masses during that span. We will cancel the evening Mass on October 15, all Masses on October 16, and the morning Masses on October 17.


