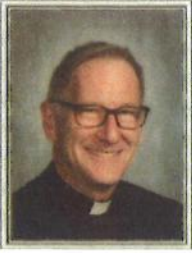

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



Monday is November 4, the Feast of St. Charles. We will celebrate his Feast Day this weekend as well as Monday. St. Charles was a towering figure in Church history. He lived in the 16th century at a time when Europe was at war, a plague was passing through, Priests were selling indulgences, Bishops were living in palaces, many Priests were uneducated, and the Church was being splintered by the Protestant Reformation. St. Charles spent his life trying to bring about the changes that were needed to make us a holier Church. We have a noble patron for our parish. St. Charles is known as a patron saint for seminaries and seminarians. We pray in a special way for our seminarians and for those who may receive that holy call.

November is a month when we focus especially on those who have died and when we pray for all of the souls in purgatory. We will keep our book with the names of deceased loved ones in the sanctuary throughout the month of November. Please add any names which haven't been written in the book in years past.

Some may remember: during our church renovation, we made a list of all of the St. Charles funerals dating back from 1957 until the renovation. A list of 2259 names was laminated and sealed inside the marble altar under our tabernacle. We have many loved ones to remember in prayer at our Masses.

Fr. Bobby will be away on retreat from Monday through Friday this week. I will be away on retreat the following Monday through Friday, Nov. 11-15.

A word about our school window project: For the time being, everything is on hold. We rented the portable classrooms not knowing that permits are needed from both the state and the county. Nor did we know that the portable units must be ten feet away from an existing building. For now, we can't use those classrooms. It is going to be very expensive and likely take some months to move the portable units, have them rewired, and pass inspection. We are looking at options before deciding on our next move. For now, our students are all in the school building and since workers don't have access to those rooms, the construction project is on hold.

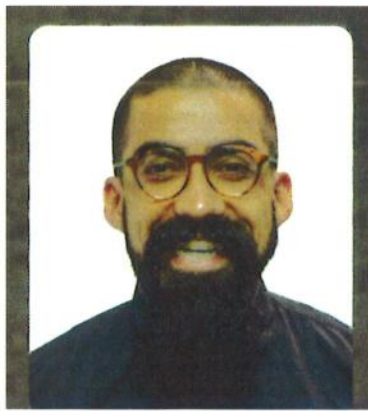

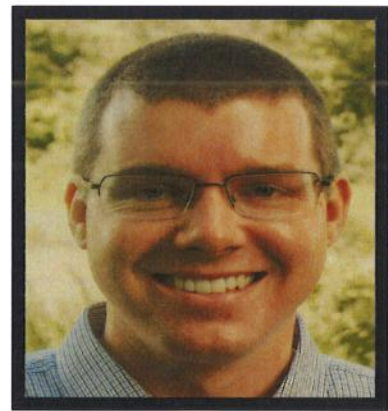
