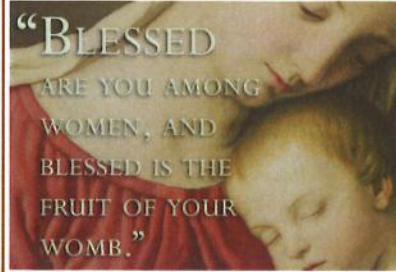

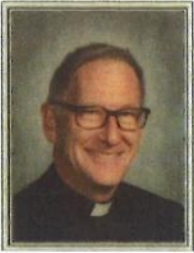

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



We are in our last days of preparation for Christmas. School is out, many people are off of work, and the time is drawing near. Let's be sure that our focus remains where it needs to be: we are preparing for Jesus. He needs to be the center of attention.

Please invite family and friends to a Christmas Mass. Christmas is an easy time to make an invitation and we would

love to have an overflowing church for all five Christmas Masses. Our prayer is that a heart will be touched by a Christmas Mass and someone will become regular in practicing the faith. It is up to God to touch hearts; our role is to invite.

A reminder of our Christmas Masses:

-Tuesday, 4:00 p.m. This will be the biggest Mass of the year, with hundreds of children and overflow seating in the Gathering Space. Our Parish Chamber Singers will lead the music along with the organ and a group of professional woodwinds.

-Tuesday, 6:30 p.m. Seating will be easily available at this Mass. The Parish Children's Choir will sing and we will use incense.

-Midnight. The Parish Choir, a professional brass ensemble, and our organ will lead a concert of sacred music beginning at 11:30 p.m. At midnight, the Christmas Proclamation will be sung in the dark. Then we will light candles throughout the church as we sing "Silent Night" and begin the most formal Mass of Christmas. Incense will be used.

-Wednesday 9:00 a.m. A beautiful Mass of Christmas morning

-Wednesday 11:00 a.m. Our final Mass on Christmas day.

We still have last-minute opportunities for confessions before Christmas. Priests will be available at our regular confession times, 7:30 a.m.-8:00 a.m. both Monday and Tuesday. We will also offer confessions on Monday afternoon, from 2:30 p.m.4:30 p.m.

For those looking for a bit of fun during Christmas week, you might consider a drive to Mishawaka on Friday evening, December 27, for the Cupertino Classic. This friendly basketball game features the Seminarians and Priests of our diocese. The game begins at 6:30 p.m. at Marian High School. The odds makers are not predicting that our parish seminarians, Noah and Sam, will be stars in the game...but there could be a surprise. Sadly, Fr. James, Fr. Bobby and I have not made the roster for the priest team.

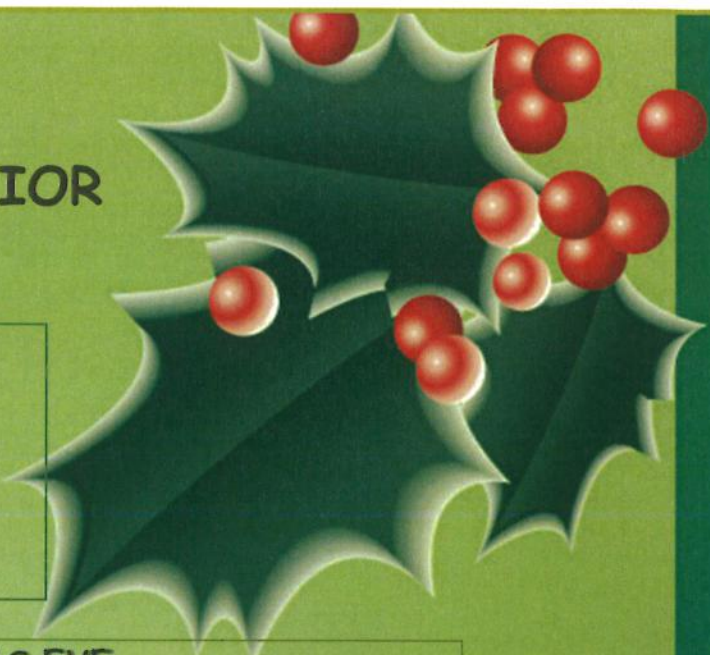

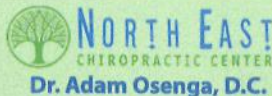
